



## Conversation cards – SunSmart Workplaces

These conversation cards are designed to help managers and team leaders start simple, meaningful conversations with workers about sun safety. They are not a test, lecture or compliance check — they are a way to listen, learn and build shared understanding about UV risk and protection at work.

**Instructions:** Use these questions to start a conversation about sun safety with staff who work outside. You can ask one of these questions during a regular staff meeting, while traveling between job sites or during informal check-ins.




You don't need to use every card at once. Regular, short conversations are more effective than one-off discussions.

**Do you think sun exposure is a risk for you/your team at work?**


**Why/why not?**

- What is not working well?


